Role Purpose: To conduct experimental (*in vivo* and *in vitro*) work in Cooper Laboratory, Respiratory Sciences

Resources Managed: Under instruction to work in the laboratory and within the animal facility to study the immunology of lung disease.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- As a Research Technician in the Cooper group, you will carry out specific laboratory-based experiments on research projects investigating the immunological basis of immunity to tuberculosis and on human immune responses.
- The research will use immunological methods to induce, collect and analyze immune cells. Cells may be derived from human or animal sources.
- Prepare for and conduct defined experiments, record data and present findings accurately using the scientific method and under guidance from the investigators.
- To keep accurate and clear written records of experimental data and present findings to their supervisor and assist with routine data recording and input to a computer database.
- To assist with the development and validation new experimental techniques as identified by research project lead.
- Operate a range of specialist laboratory equipment (with training) adhering to the relevant COSHH regulations and safety standards.
- To help in the day-to-day running of the laboratory and carry out general laboratory housekeeping duties and maintenance of laboratory equipment.

Internal and External Relationships

- To receive instruction and work in daily close contact with Prof Cooper, Dr Pearl, and Dr Das to plan and deliver specific tasks on/over a weekly basis.
- Attending group meetings to ensure up to date knowledge of the work of the group (approximately once a week)

Planning and Organising

• Interact closely on daily work requirement with line manager to identify and resolve any immediate problems.













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- Under instruction you will be ordering supplies and equipment to meet the requirements of the research.
- Planning own workload in conjunction with the requirements of the project and that the laboratory receives overall support.
- Perform activities to appropriate time and quality requirements, following established procedures.
- Plan and prioritise own work for the week or weeks ahead to deliver scheduled services but with attendance at required times.
